

## **Technical Report**

#### MAY MEETING RECAP

#### **Elections**

#### **ASPE Meeting Schedule**

The May meeting brought our technical programs to a close for the 2009-2010 season of our ASPE Chicago Regional Chapter. As Vice-president Technical, it was my responsibility to provide you with quality presenters, this would have been impossible without the help from our Affiliate members and the support of the Board of Directors.

#### **Previous Technical Report**

"Fire Protection Basics for Plumbing Engineers" by Brian Conway, PE of Great Lakes Plumbing and Heating

During this presentation, Brian provided an excellent overview of the requirements to safely protect a building and its occupants against fire. He reviewed the types of fire protection systems such as wet, dry, pre-action, deluge and antifreeze systems. Also, he covered materials, pumps, and occupancy classifications.

He also provided the following information regarding Electric Fire Pump Controllers. Note that this change will be effective **July 1, 2010**.

#### **UL, FM & NFPA Changes on Electric Fire Pump Controllers**

- The Electric Fire Pump Controllers must be equipped with a solenoid drain valve activated by a
  pushbutton in order to perform a Run Test similar to what is supplied on the Diesel Fire Pump
  Controllers as standard. This change is imposed by FM.
- 2. The surge arrestors must meet the latest UL standard. Please check with each manufacturer.
- 3. All transfer switches must be set-up for what has traditionally been called a second utility installation. This change comes from NFPA 20 (2010), UL and FM.
- 4. The three changes above are effective July 1, 2010. This means that any Electric Fire Pump Controller or Electric Fire Pump Controller with Transfer Switch built and shipped as of this date must incorporate the three changes above.
