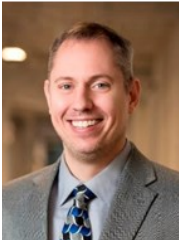

CODE CORRIDOR

From the pen of Scott Jagodzinski, VP Legislative

There is not a lot of new stuff popping up in city codes but I did find this nice little legislation tidbit.

In the City of Chicago a new legislation has passed that would require buildings to start measuring building energy usage as a benchmarking method. This benchmarking process includes water consumption. The legislation will be effective starting 06-11-2018. *For those that may not be in the know, Chicago has previously passed a requirement to implement water meters in all buildings (with some exceptions of course), including residences.* Now the new legislation for benchmarking will be used to provide a rating system for building to indicate their ranking in the benchmark metrics. Buildings will be rated on a 4 star system. Buildings who fail to report energy reports will receive a Zero rating. And an additional half-star will be awarded for those close to the maximum that meet extra city requirements.

From what I can gather the building ratings will likely be published as a tool in city records to note the greenness of the city's housing to promote and advertise the positive approaches buildings show for energy savings and efficient energy practices. Personally I think this measure, if done properly, can be a strong measure for changing the decline in population in the city. Only time will tell.

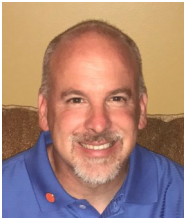
