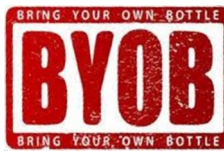

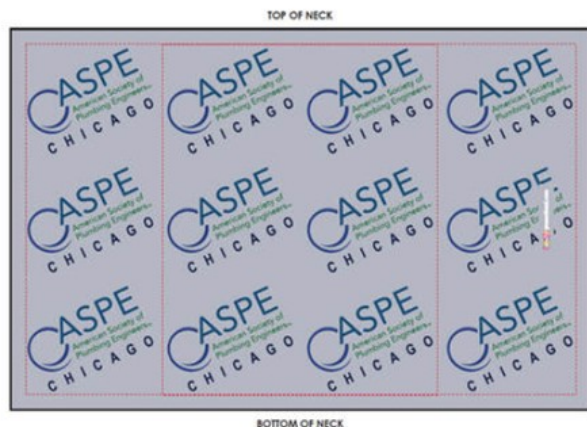

The amendments were not on the agenda for the Committee on Zoning, Landmarks, and Building Standards meeting held on December 1, but I am hoping they make an appearance on the agenda for the next scheduled committee meeting on December 15. If you would like to review a draft copy of the proposed amendments, please reach out to me ASPE.Chicago.VPL@gmail.com.

Please continue to be part of the development of the future Chicago Plumbing Code! If you have not done so, please submit the Top 5 items you like and dislike about the current code, along with your reasoning. All lists should be submitted to DOBCommissioner@cityofchicago.org. Previously submitted lists were considered for the proposed interim amendments and will continue to be considered as part of the International Plumbing Code adoption.

Alternate Plumbing Materials Pilot Program: The Alternate Plumbing Materials Pilot Program is set to **expire on December 31, 2020**. It is my understanding that this program will continue to be extended until interim amendments are passed and/or the International Plumbing Code is adopted.

State of Illinois Updates

There has been no action related to the State of Illinois Plumbing Code. Additionally, there are no scheduled Illinois Plumbing Code Advisory Council Meetings. If that changes, I will let you know.

Facility Guidelines Institute

If you participated in the ASPE Digital Experience, you may have attended the two-part session related to the converting McCormick Place into an Alternative Care Facility, which I found to be quite interesting. During that session, the speaker indicated that the Facility Guidelines Institute is scheduled to release a white paper to highlight design standards for emergency conditions for future emergency situations, including pandemics and weather events. As you can imagine, much has been learned over the last few months and hopefully this will lead to a better and more efficient implementation in the future.

The public will have an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed standards through January 2021, which may be of specific interest to any of you that are involved in hospital work. A revised version of the emergency conditions standards is expected to be issued in January of 2022. 2024 International Plumbing Code & Uniform Plumbing Codes

If you are interested in proposing code changes for the 2024 International or Uniform Plumbing Codes, you still have time to submit changes.



To submit code changes directly to the International Code Council (ICC), due by January 10, 2021, register for free or login to your "cdpACCESS" <https://www.cdpassess.com/login/> and use the online templates.

To submit code changes directly to the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officers (IAPMO), due by January 4, 2021, send an email to standards@IAPMOstandards.org with "Proposal for change" in the subject line.

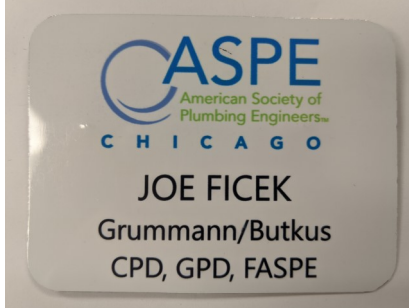
