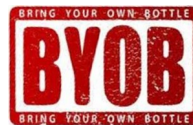

CPD Renewal Coming Up For Some of You:

For those of you who have your CPD renewal coming up, DO NOT WAIT UNTIL YOUR RENEWAL IS DUE ON April 30th. I am being told the system is NOT currently working... that said here are some notes I took when I recertified 14 or so months ago:

24 hours of education in total are required to recertify your CPD/CPDT. ASPE's certification portal is now tracking CEUs as "points" so 1 hour of continuing education, (CEU), or 1 Professional Development Hour", (PDH), = 10 points.

At least 50% of the training, (i.e. 12 hours), must be from ASPE, (through ASPE the Society, via ASPE Chapter Technical Meeting OR ASPE approved courses from an ASPE approved provider). CEU's from the ASPE Chicago Chapter Technical meetings are automatically being added to your ASPE education account as of September 2019, (we used to email these to you).

Note that these will be reviewed by Society staff and the Credentialing Committee and will therefore hold up your recertification timeline – ASPE SUGGESTS YOU SUBMIT THESE WELL IN ADVANCE OF YOUR CPD/CPDT EXPIRATION DATE: <https://education.aspe.org/CPDRecertExternal>

The CPD/CPDT recertification review process can take 5-10 BUSINESS days. DO NOT wait until 4/30 to recertify, especially if you plan on submitting external/non-ASPE approved training CEUs/PDHs such as chapter meetings from prior to September 2019!

THE FOLLOWING SCREEN SHOTS AND STEPS ARE INTENDED TO WALK YOU THROUGH HOW TO CHECK THE AMOUNT OF ASPE APPROVED TRAINING YOU CURRENTLY HAVE OBTAINED. This is only valid for CPDs due to recertify by April 30, 2021. CPDs due April 30, 2022 and CPDTs will not appear there yet, but hopefully in early 2022 you'll receive information from Society regarding this

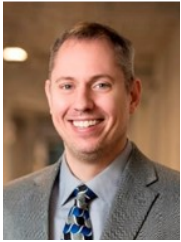

International Code Council – 2024 Codes

The process of updating the International Plumbing Code for the 2024 edition, is in full swing. Did you submit changes to the code or is your curiosity piqued by what others may have proposed? If so, the International Code Council has released the code change monograph, which includes proposed changes to the Plumbing, Mechanical, Fuel Gas, Fire Code, and Building Codes in addition to other I-Codes that may be of interest to you. You can download the document by following this link <https://www.iccsafe.org/wp-content/uploads/2021-Group-A-Complete-Proposed-Changes-compressed.pdf>



Get involved! The Committee Action Hearings to discuss the proposed changes are scheduled to begin on April 11th, but the hearings related to the Plumbing, Mechanical, Fuel Gas, and Fire codes will not begin until April 25th. If you are interested in observing or testifying, you may do so virtually and are required to register by visiting this link <https://www.iccsafe.org/about/news-and-events/2021-cah/> From what I understand, the hearings can provide some good entertainment value, but at a minimum, you can get a peek behind the curtain and possibly motivate you to be part of the change.

City of Chicago Updates

We are still waiting for the proposed Chicago Plumbing Code, Mechanical Code, and Fuel Gas Code amendments to be put in front of the City Council. The next scheduled meeting for the Zoning, Landmarks, and Building Standards Committee is April 20, 2021 and the agenda has not yet been posted. Water Services and Electrical Grounding

My firm was recently brought on-board to resolve a grounding issue for a project where the electrical ground for multiple site development buildings, was inadvertently lost when the site water service was replaced as part of an infrastructure improvement. Although this instance happened to existing buildings that were not undergoing any interior work, it made me realize how easily a similar situation could be overlooked unless we are familiar with what the Civil Engineer may be doing beyond the limits of our typical scope of work.

The National Electric Code (NEC) or Chicago Electrical Code (CEC), Section 250, specifies the grounding electrode requirements for a building. The code requires that a building be provided with two (2) electrical grounds, a primary and supplemental ground. One of the more traditional methods used for grounding is to use the incoming metallic water service as a ground. If the water service is to be used as a ground, the metallic piping must have direct contact with the earth for a minimum of 10 feet.



You may be asking how the ground was inadvertently lost on the aforementioned project? The property owner for this large site development replaced the existing metallic water mains that were corroding due to acidic soil conditions, with non-metallic piping. Unfortunately, the service taps were replaced to within 3 feet of the impacted buildings. The local Electrical Inspector found out about the project after the work had already been completed, resulting in plenty of heart-ache for those involved. I can imagine someone needing a Snickers candy bar after that was revealed. As the fictitious endzone painter for the KC Chiefs famously said after realizing his painting error, "Great Googly Moogly!"

As non-metallic water mains and services become more common, it is important to notify the Electrical Engineer if they will not be able to use the water service as a grounding method. The Electrical Engineer has multiple ground options available to them if the traditional method may not be available. Review the service materials to be used with the Civil Engineer and keep in mind that even though you may specify a metallic water service, the Civil Engineer may be intending to extend a non-metallic material to within a few feet of the building for connection by the Plumbing Contractor. Coordination is always key to avoiding costly revisions in the field!

Please reach out to me if you have any code questions, code updates, ideas for topics of discussion, or you are looking for any interpretations and I will try and include pertinent information in future newsletters.

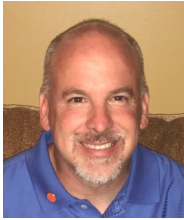

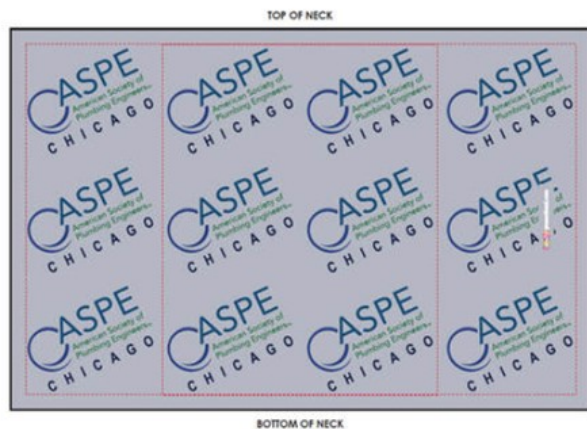

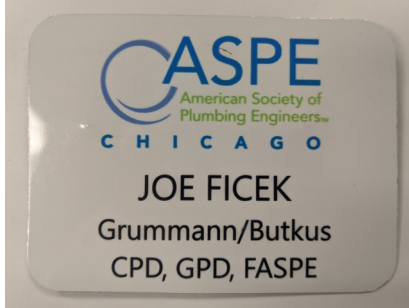
