

VICE PRESIDENT, TECHNICAL: TECHNICALLY SPEAKING

Greetings Chicago Chapter!

Eventually all the gloom of this spring will turn into sunshine and warmer temperatures, right? This weather is preventing me from a much needed warm-up for the golf outing on June 17th, not that it would help much! I am looking forward to what should be a spectacular outing at our new venue this year at Makray Memorial Golf Club being put together by our Golf Committee.

Thank you to everyone that came out to Church Street Brewing Co last month! It was a new venue for us that I think was well received but did have some drawbacks. I appreciate the honest feedback I received, which revolved mostly around the noisy acoustics within the room that made it difficult for some to hear. If we go back to the location next year, please know that we will address the acoustic issues. We never know how a meeting will go at a new venue until we try, which is why your feedback is extremely important. If you have any other feedback, please let me know. Thank you to TJ Higgins Co for sponsoring the Cocktail Hour and thank you to Mark Luczak from HSA for filling in for Phil Traynor to give a presentation on American Gas Safety as part of the Manufacturer Spotlight. Lastly, thank you to Craig Froeter for his great presentation on "Performance Roof Drain Design" with a lot of important information regarding roof drains. Below are some key takeaways from the presentation:

- Drains are not created equal and will not perform the same. Unfortunately, flow data is not yet readily available
 across manufacturers.
- Pay attention to the free area of the dome strainers when comparing drains.
- Correct installation of a roof drain is vital in preventing excessive ponding and helping the drain flow efficiently. Things to be mindful of include the position of the clamping collar in relation to the surrounding roof area and the size of the hole cut into the roof membrane on the interior of the drain. The membrane is a common issue I see in the field, so please make sure to check if the membrane is cut back as far as possible to allow adequate flow into the drain in collaboration with the roofer.
- Secondary drains must perform just as well as the primary drain, so be mindful when selecting between an internal or external dam.



I know not many of you are Cheeseheads – and that's alright, we all have our teams. We have plenty of time to chat about it before the season begins. In the meantime, golfing season has officially started, hope to see you in June!

City of Chicago Updates:

The changes to the City of Chicago Plumbing Code are now legally a part of the code as of March 1st. I would recommend reading through the changes in the link below in advance of working on your projects in the city. https://www.chicago.gov/content/dam/city/depts/bldgs/general/CodeModernization/O2021-4134.pdf

In the May newsletter I promised to highlight the changes that were implemented, but after going through it, the repetition from the November newsletter and the clarity found in the above link made the effort not worthwhile. Please be familiar with the amendments in the ordinance, and you can ask me for clarification or a copy of the November newsletter with my viewpoints on the changes.

Your kitchen sink, and what is not okay to put down the drain!: I hope you enjoy this departure from my normally lengthy write-ups. Drains can clog up from a variety of sources, and if that source isn't placed down the drain – it could save you hundreds or thousands of dollars if the drain doesn't need to be fixed. I am aware that we are in the plumbing industry, so we each "know a guy" that can help us out, but let's stay focused on not clogging the drain.

Anything that is large, or that is "fine" should be avoided - Large items would include peels from anything you're slicing/peeling. If you're peeling potatoes (or carrots, onions, broccoli, etcetera), you could try what I do — put a bag over the drain in the sink and peel into the sink like you normally do and at the end, grab the ends of the bag and toss all the peels away. Little slivers of peel could remain in the sink, and that's up to you to clean out of sink. Some moderate amount of waste can be handled by the disposer, but excess amounts are not good.

"Fine" foods that shouldn't go down your drain are food items that are small and can collect within the pipe to form blockages. The common culprits are grease and coffee grounds. In residential we don't have individual grease traps, so draining your grease should be handled with caution. Personally I have a number of diapers always in my trash can so I can pour the grease from pan directly onto diapers and it'll be soaked into the diaper. I have these plastic scrapers that I can scrape as much grease off the pan and into the garbage can. The remainder will go down the drain, but nothing is perfect and we got the most we could. Coffee ground and egg shells are items that go great for sprinkling across your lawn or into your garden as fertilizer. Within a drain, the grounds and shells collect and can make a thick paste/blockage when settled.

Be careful with what you put down the drain, scrape your plate into the trash can and you can thank me later! International Code Council - 2024 Codes:

The process of updating the International Building Codes for the 2024 edition, is still underway. There have not been any recent updates from the Committee Action Hearings in Spring, I will be continually monitoring this.

State of Illinois Updates:

There has been no action related to the State of Illinois Plumbing Code. Additionally, there are no scheduled Illinois Plumbing Code Advisory Council Meetings. If that changes, I will let you know. 


