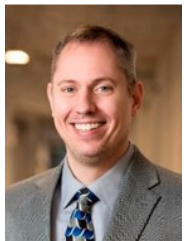

## **VICE PRESIDENT, LEGISLATIVE**

Greetings Chicago Chapter Members!

Hope to see you at the golf outing this month! Would love to hear the feedback on my attempts at sharing knowledge, and maybe any topics you would want me to explore in future newsletters!

### **City of Chicago Updates:**

The changes to the City of Chicago Plumbing Code are now legally a part of the code as of March 1<sup>st</sup>. I would recommend reading through the changes in the link below in advance of working on your projects in the city.

### **International Code Council – 2024 Codes:**

The process of updating the International Building Codes for the 2024 edition, is still underway. There have not been any recent updates from the Committee Action Hearings in Spring, I will be continually monitoring this.

### **State of Illinois Updates:**

There has been no action related to the State of Illinois Plumbing Code. Additionally, there are no scheduled Illinois Plumbing Code Advisory Council Meetings. If that changes, I will let you know. ### **Water Heaters and Electrification:**

Electrification. Have you heard of this term? At SmithGroup, we have offices across the country and in California there is a large push to stop using fossil fuels. Not just with gasoline powered vehicles, but also to remove natural gas from homes and commercial buildings!

I can see how the warmer weather in California would allow for not relying on natural gas to keep a building warm, but I often wonder how the restaurants are dealing with the inability to use natural gas. I digress.

As it relates to water heating, if natural gas is not an option and assuming there isn't steam available: How does one heat water for the showers and sinks?

There of course are electric resistance heat exchangers, which are ~100% efficient. But it is costly energy to raise the temperature of water using electric resistance water heaters.

The best answer is to use heat pumps! There are air-cooled types and water-cooled types. Heat pumps use refrigerant as a media to transfer heat into the potable water. In California, air-cooled types are widely used because the temperature stays above 40°F, and this is suitable to still be able to extract heat from the air. In colder climates, air-cooled heat pumps do not work as well below 40°F; however one manufacturer claims to be reliable down to -4°F.

The benefits of using a heat pump to heat your water is that it uses less energy to do more water heating! A water heater's Coefficient of Performance (COP) is the unit benchmark to determine how efficient the product is.

You may be wondering how heat pumps can ever be used in Chicago, the answer is water-cooled. There are various forms of water that can be used as your heat-sink:

- Geothermal
- Condenser water from a cooling tower
- Heating Hydronic water
  - ◇ There are high-limits on the inlet to heat pumps, so a fancy 3-valve bypass with recirc pump would be needed
  - ◇ If your water temperature from the HVAC folks is high enough and would be reliable year-round to be above 140°F, you might want to consider water-to-water heat exchangers instead of a heat pump. But if the loop would lose temperature during the summer months, you may need to install that fancy 3-valve bypass with a pump so your heat pumps can operate within the manufacturer's guidelines

- Sanitary wastewater

- ◇ I've used these on a couple projects, none installed yet, but they seem great to use. You end up storing the sanitary wastewater on-site in large vessels and the manufacturer has temperature relays set up to move water out of vessels to Civil and then replenish the vessels with warmer water.

What do you think of Electrification? Are you convinced this is a positive movement for the world to use less fossil fuels? Do you have a project that might be able to use this?

p.s. I do have this fantasy about air-cooled heat pump water heaters being placed into mechanical rooms that are unbearably hot. Think of all that heat sitting idly and available to be put into potable water. But, there is a chance that the heat pump could make the room 40°F in short order if too many showers are taken...especially if all the steam and hydronic piping is properly insulated. Do you see air-cooled heat pumps being viable in Chicago?

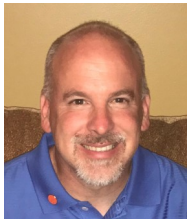
