



Have any of you completed a project including designing the system, specifying "certain things in a particular way", get hired to perform a punch walk, identify the "certain thing not installed in the particular way" and then you subsequently flag that "thing" as nonconformance? If you've followed me thus far with the quotes acting as a way for you to fill-in-the-blank, then...have you then had the contractor and/or owner come back to you saying that in order to make the "thing" conform to the project manual,

that it will cost extra money? I'm not saying the contractor is holding their hand out to us, but it would seem the owner shouldn't foot the bill in these situations.

If you've got a knack for handling these situations, I'd love to hear how you navigate! Maybe I'm ranting or maybe I'm preaching to the choir, but it seems there is inconsistency with project workflow and I think we all ought to talk about it more so that open communication can make its way around the world and we can lower stress for everybody one project at a time. This could make its way onto next month's newsletter! We can keep it anonymous, but I'll be at the next meeting in case you would like to chat and share ideas.

I also want to <u>run a poll below</u> for what content you would love to learn more about. I'm toying with the idea of creating short 1-3 minute videos for you all and your support staff. I'm a Bluebeam champion, and trying to squeeze 10 hours of work into an 8 hour day is my goal most days. Knowing the tools that are at your grasp is a way for you to increase your productivity, make your deadlines and still log off in time for Wheel of Fortune.

Three topics to Poll:

- 1. Have you heard of Bluebeam, Revit, or OneNote? Which software do you want to know more about?
- 2. If you know these programs, which feature do you hear a lot about but do not know what they do, or how they're used?
- 3. Have you used Bluebeam Studio? Do you know how to maximize mark-up processing, alert/notification workflow and document management?
 - a. With these three tools, I can most certainly guarantee that production time (drafting and modeling) can be reduced 20% with effective use of the tools Bluebeam offers.

State of Illinois Updates:






