VICE PRESIDENT, TECHNICAL: TECHNICALLY SPEAKING...CONTINUED

Presentation Summary: The presentation will consist of observing and participating in live demonstrations and hands on activities led by Frank Borkowski, with assistance from current apprentices and some willing vendors. Demonstrations will include observing how wastewater reacts with waste fittings (clear) serving a bank of flush valve water closets. Additionally, there will be demonstrations on the assembly of closet carriers, and hands-on training activities, including cast iron, copper, and plastic pipe fitting methods, and backflow preventer testing and maintenance.

Presenter Bio:

Frank Borkowski – Instructor at Charge – Plumbers Local 130 Training Center (Chicago).

Frank has been a plumber for about 33 years. He has spent 25 of those years as an instructor, 18 years as a full-time day instructor for 18 years.

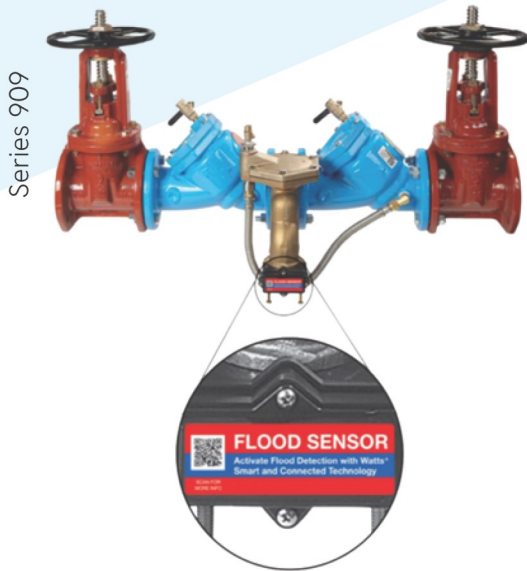

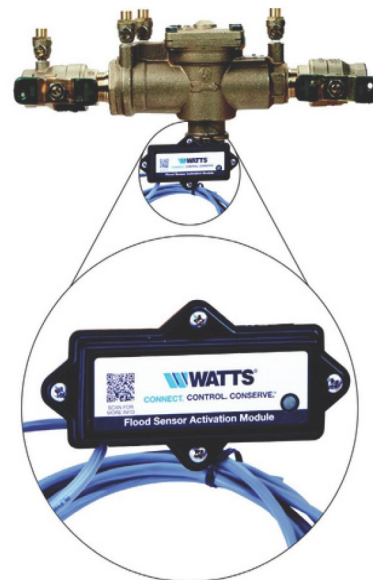

Electrification:

What do you all know about electrification? Have you heard that fossil fuels are being outlawed across the US? In 2019, Berkeley, California was the first city to outlaw the use of natural gas in their city. Then, as recently as this month, the state of New York has signed into law the ban of natural gas appliances in new buildings. It's an amazing feat to be observing! I think at some point this would make its way to Chicago, and the Midwest, whether we like it or not. And, unlike those places, Chicago consistently has subzero temperatures each winter. Hearing what electrification is attempting sounds impossible. Think of all the heating output that natural gas gives to the world, to the City of Chicago, and to your house. The electric grid is not set up to replace the heating output of natural gas! In general, I would expect power demand to increase 20%-50% depending on the establishment.

The truth of the matter is something we are all aware. Fossil fuels that took millions of years to be created can all be mined and exhausted in the next several decades. Oil looks to have ~30-40 years and Natural gas looks to have ~100 years before these are exhausted.

Taking action now could be pre-mature, there are higher costs with replacing natural gas heat with electric-heat. However, is there a better time to start trying to extend our resources? Waiting now and starting the day before the world exhausts natural gas sounds like a terrible time for "future us" or for the younger generations. Flattening the curve on natural gas use will likely have better long-term results than the last time the world tried to flatten the curve. If nothing else, it can serve as a catalyst to solve the hydrogen fuel cell problem. Switching the world from natural gas to hydrogen gas use would be an easier transition, but is not a valid solution based on my research into the matter. So, as of 2023, the world's braintrust is writing laws to have the world heated with electricity rather than natural gas.

Are you ready for the challenge? What do you think? I'd love to have a discussion about any or all of these topics, I'm here to learn and to share what I'm learning.
